POLICY BULLETIN NO. 3-3

SUBJECT: SPECIAL REQUESTS FOR DISCONNECTION

I. POLICY:

Members who request to be disconnected for a period of time less than twelve (12) months will be required to pay an advance when reconnected.

II. PROCEDURE:

- A. The Cooperative does not freely grant requests for disconnection for periods of non-use. The Cooperative has invested member's money for the installation of these facilities and it is not equitable to allow members to do this.
- B. However, if a member insists upon being disconnected for a period of time less than twelve (12) months, they shall be subject to:
 - 1. Reconnection fee, and
 - 2. Advance payment of six (6) months cost of service which will be a credit to the account, but is not refundable. These fees are payable before service will be reconnected and are listed on the Schedule of Fees. Advance payment of six months minimum charge applies to security light reconnections when light was disconnected for non-use for less than a 12-month period.
- C. Disconnects for periods of over twelve (12) months will be treated as any other new member.
