POLICY BULLETIN NO 3-7

SUBJECT: TESTING METERS

I. POLICY:

To provide the member with the most accurate billing possible, the Cooperative will test the member's meter on a regularly scheduled basis in addition to testing the meter at the member's request.

II. PROCEDURE:

- A. All meters will be tested on a regularly scheduled basis by trained co-op personnel. The tolerance will be 2 percent fast or slow.
 - 1. Single-phase meters will be tested within a ten (10) year cycle.
 - 2. Special single-phase and three-phase meters will be tested within a four (4) year cycle.
 - 3. Billings will be corrected to a determinable date or reading based on past history of the account when a meter has stopped, when it has incorrectly metered use or when an incorrect reading has been used. If undeterminable, then adjustments will be made for a four (4) month period based on four (4) months use.
- B. A member may request to have a meter tested by paying a test fee (see schedule of fees). This fee will be refunded if results are outside of tolerances.
 - 1. A copy of test results will be mailed to the member.
